Position Summary

The processing room is Spectrum Foods' USDA inspected further processing operation. Employees help to cut chicken, beef, and pork products, as custom cuts or standard cuts for the benefit of our customers to ensure that they get exactly what they want. Processing room employees typically arrive to the warehouse at approximately 03:45 AM and continue to process within the room until clean up occurs at 12:00 noon. Specific items and cuts will be directed based on the customers needs from management to the processing room staff.

Benefits

Responsibilities

- Pull inventory from stock locations and bring to processing room for production.
- Lift items and cases of products in a safe manner to protect the employee's body, while best fulfilling the needs of the company's customers.
- Prepare orders in accordance with the hazard analysis and critical control points (HACCP) plan, good manufacturing practices (GMP's), and various other standards to ensure the safety of the general public.
- Follow the directions of management to prioritize customer needs to best service all customers.
- Remove trash as well as clean and sanitize the processing room daily and as needed.
- Operate powered industrial trucks (PIT) in a safe, efficient, and responsible manner.
- Attend all required meetings of employees.
- Be available for overtime work, which is sometimes unannounced.

• Complete additional functions as required/needed by warehouse management.

Requirements

- Ability to work in the United States of America and be E-Verified.
- Ability to read, write, and perform basic arithmetic.
- Ability to successfully follow directions and assignments as given by management.
- Ability to work effectively with others and as a member of a team or leader.
- Ability to lift up to 75 LBS.
- Ability to reach and lift products, in some situations, above your head safely.
- Ability to squat and lift products, in some situations, from the ground safely.
- Ability to safely operate powered industrial trucks (PIT).
- Ability to safely operate knives and band saws for proper processing of meat items for human consumption.
- Ability to work in different environments (hot, refrigerated, freezing, wet, etc.).
- Ability to adapt to unique and different situations and work well under stress.
- Ability to remain on your feet, whether walking or standing in the same area, for up to 6-8 hours a day.
- Ability to arrive to work on time.
